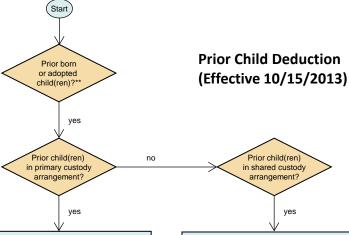
**Prior children" include children from a different relationship who were born or adopted before the children in this case.



Non-custodial parent can deduct

- \$0 for in-kind* support, and
- up to 90.3(a)(2) primary amount for actual support ordered and paid

Custodial parent can deduct

- up to 90.3(a)(2) primary amount for in-kind* support, and
- \$0 for actual support received
- * In-kind support means support contributed for the children that is not a direct payment to the other parent or an agency.

Each parent does the following calculation: 90.3(a)(2) primary custody amount

- x 90.3(b) percentage custody of prior children
- = 90.3(a)(1)(D) in-kind* support deduction
- 90.3(a)(1)(C) actual support ordered & paid
 total allowed deduction, not to exceed
 90.3(a)(2) amount

Example 1:

Facts. Father has 45% shared custody of 2 prior children. Child support ordered and actually paid by Father for those 2 prior children is \$200 per month. Based on Father's current income, his primary support amount for the two children if they were his only children would be \$13,500 per year.

Math.

90.3(a)(2) primary	\$13,500
x 90.3(b) custody %	45%
= 90.3(a)(1)(D) in-kind*	\$6,075
+ 90.3(a)(1)(C) actual	\$2,400
= total allowed deduction	\$8,475

Example 2:

<u>Facts.</u> Father has 45% shared custody of 2 prior children. Child support ordered and actually paid by Father for those 2 prior children is \$700 per month. Based on Father's current income, his primary support amount for the two children if they were his only children would be \$13,500 per year.

90.3(a)(2) primary	\$13,500	
x 90.3(b) custody %	<u>45%</u>	
= 90.3(a)(1)(D) in-kind*	\$6,075	
+ 90.3(a)(1)(C) actual	\$8,400	
= total allowed deduction	\$14,475 \$13,500	
Note: \$14,475 is more than the 90.3(a)(2)		
primary amount, so Father's deduction for the		
prior children is limited to \$13,500
