I have my sign-in sheet going around, 13 14 so I ask that everybody please sign in and fill out all the information, and just write it as neat as 15 16 I will appreciate that. you can. 17 If any questions come up after the 18 meeting that you guys, you know, think of, just I ask that you send them to our dot-ask, our e-mail 19 If you don't have it, I have it here. 20 address. 21 that way we can review the question, answer it in a 22 post for everyone -- so everyone has all the same 23 information. 24 Before I hand it over to the project



1 manager, there's just a few things I want to go over 2 from a contracting standpoint. The first is everyone is aware of our 3 4 drug testing program; is that correct? I don't need to go over anything, or it's all pretty -- all 5 6 (Everyone nodding heads) 7 There is a -- well, this particular project incorporates an Appendix A, Technical 8 Specifications, which is posted on the web, so I'm 9 sure you know about it. So I'm just reiterating 10 11 just to take a look at that when you get a chance, 12 if you haven't already. Our bid forms: As a reminder, I 13 14 think that this project -- I think it's only one. 15 Yeah, there is only one bid item for this one. 16 I ask that you don't leave anything blank on our bid 17 Don't put a zero. You know, put a number form. And please make sure you type 18 other than zero. everything. You know, just use the EBS file that 19 came with the project. 20 21 We have a drug affidavit form in the proposal, itself, that must be filled out, 22 23 notarized. And please submit that with your bid, 24 as well as we will need an affidavit for any



1 subcontractors, as well. So not only yourself at the time of bid opening, but any subcontractors that 2 you might have. 3 4 As a reminder on our certification page, we have got our certification information, 5 addendum acknowledgment, final questions and answers 6 7 date, and a bid bond, as well as an affirmation I'm sure you guys are all familiar with it. 8 page. All those forms are at the end of the 9 And, just as a reminder, to fill them out 10 proposal. 11 completely, and they all must be returned with your 12 bid. Anything that needs to be notarized, 13 14 you know, make sure it gets notarized. 15 Since we are altering a building, 16 Delaware Code states that we need to come up with 17 subcontractor categories for this project. I'm sure 18 you guys are all familiar with this. Correct? So what will happen is we will come 19 up with a listing of categories. And then, once we 20 21 have that listing, I will go back to the office in the next couple of days, I'll do up an addendum, and 22 23 I'll post those categories on our website. Just print off that form. 24 Make sure



1 you fill out that form completely of subcontractor categories, and then submit that with your bid, 2 as well. Like I said, I will post that as an 3 4 addendum on the web so you guys can all just grab it there. 5 And that's all I really have. 6 7 come up with the categories now, or I can have the 8 project manager go over the project first, whatever 9 you guys prefer. Maybe we should talk about it 10 first. 11 MR. SCHLITTER: All right. That's 12 fine. I'm Matt Schlitter, the project manager. from Central District Maintenance and Operations. 13 14 I'm kind of running the project for our facilities 15 group. 16 Um, it's a pretty straightforward It's just bathroom renovations. 17 project. 18 biggest thing as far as this is ADA upgrades. So we are trying to add an ADA stall, so that's why all 19 the toilets are shifting. 20 21 So it's all new fixtures, Um, right now internally there is no 22 countertops. 23 air conditioning in the bathrooms, so adding air 24 conditioning and upgrading LED lighting. So it's,

1 what, a 180-day contract, I believe? You didn't 2 mention that. 3 MR. KOVACS: I didn't, but it is. 4 Correct. And did you mention 5 MR. SCHLITTER: 6 the trade? Did you put that on there, the trade? 7 We are supposed to put that on this contract, that 8 special trays thing. 9 MR. KOVACS: You are talking about 10 the draft terminal? 11 MR. SCHLITTER: Yeah, draft terminal. 12 MR. KOVACS: Hmm. I don't see it. If we need it, I will have to do an addendum. 13 I 14 thought -- I thought you mentioned that originally. 15 MR. SCHLITTER: No. We are going to 16 put it on this one, since it has so much different crafts. 17 18 MR. KOVACS: I'll do an addendum. 19 But the plans weren't MR. SCHLITTER: very specific. 20 21 We do need to maintain one bathroom, so a man's and a woman's bathroom at a time. 22 can't go ripping both sets of bathrooms up at one 23 24 time. So that needs to be staged. Just to make

| 6   | MR. KOVACS: Does anyone have any                    |
| 7   | questions regarding the project?                    |
| 8   | MR. SCHLITTER: We can do a                          |
| 9   | walk-through if everybody would want to do that.    |
| 10  | MR. SCARANGELLI: Jeff Scarangelli,                  |
| 11  | General Builders, Newark, or general contractor.    |
| 12  | I didn't notice any floor                           |
| 13  | replacement. It seems to be that the tile is        |
| 14  | existing to remain?                                 |
| 15  | MR. SCHLITTER: All the tile is                      |
| 16  | supposed to remain.                                 |
| 17  | MR. SCARANGELLI: In the event that                  |
| 18  | we are shifting water closets, what do we do about  |
| 19  | repairing it?                                       |
| 20  | MR. SCHLITTER: Um, just make it                     |
| 21  | blend the best you can.                             |
| 22  | MR. SCARANGELLI: All right.                         |
| 23  | MR. SCHLITTER: Try to match the                     |
