Federal Rulemaking Web Site www.Regulations.gov

- Search for your document using the NRC docket ID or the title of the document.
- From the Search Results page or the document details page, click the "Comment Now" link.
- On the comment Web form, enter your submitter information (if required) and type your comment.
- When you have finished typing your comment, click "Continue" to preview your comment.
- Once you are satisfied with your comment, click to check the box next to the statement saying you are aware that you are filing a document into an official docket. Click the "Submit Comment" button to send your comment to the Federal agency.

How to Subscribe to Updates

At the bottom of the main page under "Stay Connected," click on "GovDelivery."

- Enter your e-mail address and click "Submit."
- Subscribe by clicking to check the boxes next to the items for which you would like to receive updates, then clicking "Submit" again.

Federal Rulemaking Web Site www.Regulations.gov

- Regulations.gov allows you to receive alerts when changes or additions occur in a docket folder. To subscribe:
 - Navigate to a docket folder by searching by the Docket ID.
 - 2. Click on the "Sign up for E-mail Alerts" link.
 - Enter your e-mail address and select how frequently you would like to receive e-mails (daily, weekly, or monthly).
