

Data Sharing Problems

Mission Command, Intelligence, and Business users cannot effectively:

- Know what information resources are available to them
- Find specific information crucial to their missions
- Provide (securely) information to others who may need it
- Adjust information support on the fly
- Determine the quality of published information
- Measure the value of information investments
- Interact directly with responsive information providers
- Incorporate new information sources rapidly into operations
- Aggregate and compare data







Army Chief Data Officer

- The senior advisor to the Secretary of the Army and the Army Chief of Staff on data issues.
- Reports directly to the Army CIO on all issues pertaining to Army data.
- Develops and implements the Army Data Management Program.
- Chairs the Army Data Board to coordinate and adjudicate enterprise data strategy, standards, policies & execution.
- Develops and coordinates the management and integration of data-related architecture and engineering products.



Army Data Steward Responsibilities

- Responsible for all aspects of data in their domain/area
- Participate as a voting member of the Army Data Board
- Integrate and configuration manage information exchange specifications and associated controlled vocabularies
- Coordinate identification and registration of authoritative data sources
- Coordinate implementation and management of enterprise identifiers
- Coordinate management and integration of information architecture
- Convene data forums to manage data issues
- Assign Functional Data Managers for capability areas/segments
- Develop and implement technical data guidance
