"Co-Parenting for Successful Kids" meets court-mandated requirements (Nebraska LB554) for parents who are divorcing, seeking custody modification, or never married and seeking custody.

INTERACTIVE COURSE

+ Nebraska Extension's online classes are interactive and include teacher feedback. Teacher feedback is what sets the Nebraska Extension class apart from many other courses.

ON-SITE CLASS

- +Offered at 7 locations across Nebraska
- +Positive educational experiences by being in a classroom with others in similar transitions.
- +No need for computer skills
- +Face-to-face learning style

ONLINE CLASS

- +Take class anytime day or night
- +Can break course up into segments to fit parents schedule.
- +Participants answer questions asked in course. Instructors respond as needed with individual help for parents.
