All snowmobiles must be 48 inches wide or less. The definition includes a child-sized snowmobile – see exceptions at dnr.wi.gov for additional information. A vehicle that has inflatable tires is not considered a snowmobile even if skis are attached. An ATV or similar machine that is converted with an aftermarket kit, complete with skis and a track cannot be registered as a snowmobile and cannot be driven on snowmobile trails.
