e) to a recipient who has provided the agency with advance adequate written assurance that the record will be used solely as a statistical research or reporting record, and the record is

to be transferred in a form that is not individually identifiable;

- f) to the National Archives of the United States as a record which has sufficient historical or other value to warrant its continued preservation by the United States Government, or for evaluation by the Administrator of General Services or his designee to determine whether the record has such value;
- g) to another agency or to an instrumentality of any governmental jurisdiction, within or under the control of the United States, for a civil or criminal law enforcement activity, if the activity is authorized by law, and if the head of the agency or instrumentality has made a written request for the agency or instrumentality has made a written request to the agency which maintains the records specifying the particular portion desired and the law enforcement activity for which the record is sought;
- h) to a person pursuant to a showing of compelling circumstances affecting the health or safety of an individual if upon such disclosure notification is transmitted to the last known address of such individual:
- i) to either House of Congress, or to the extent of matter within its jurisdiction, any committee or subcommittee thereof, any joint committee of Congress or subcommittee of any such joint committee;
- j) to the Comptroller General, or any of his authorized representatives, in the course of the performance of the duties of the General Accounting Office; or
- k) pursuant to the order of a court competent jurisdiction.

In all other circumstances you must consent prior to the disclosure of information provided herein, by the Department of Social Services.

6. Effects (Beneficial and/or Adverse) of Not Supplying All or Parts of Requested Information:

Beneficial effect is to facilitate the determination of need for basic consumption items, special need items, and services. Adverse effect is the delay or denial of assistance and/or services based upon insufficient information to determine need.
