5	SECTION 1. Section 614.013, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
7	(b-1) Subject to available resources, and to the extent
8	feasible, the methods established under Subsection (b) must ensure
9	that each offender with a mental impairment is identified and
10	qualified for the continuity of care system and serve adults with
11	severe and persistent mental illness who are experiencing
12	significant functional impairment due to a mental health disorder
13	that is defined by the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental
14	Disorders, 5th Edition (DSM-5), including:
15	(1) major depressive disorder, including single
16	episode or recurrent major depressive disorder;
17	(2) post-traumatic stress disorder;
18	(3) schizoaffective disorder, including bipolar and
19	depressive types;
20	(4) psychotic disorder;
21	(5) anxiety disorder;
22	(6) delusional disorder; or
23	(7) any other diagnosed mental health disorder that is
24	severe or persistent in nature.
