


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#### **Resource Potential**


Maps below estimate areas where wind energy could be economically viable\* when using available turbine technology. Not all areas shown can be developed.



Wind turbines were originally designed for the highest wind speed sites and were not well-suited to areas like the Southeast. 80m Height | Previous Technology Potential: 7.0 TWh/year



Recently, turbine manufacturers have designed taller towers and longer blades, improving energy output, especially at lower wind speed sites. **110m Height | Current Technology** Potential: 633.6 TWh/year



This technology trend is continuing, which significantly increases potentially viable areas for wind energy, especially in the Southeast. 140m Height | Future Technology\*\* Potential: 839.4 TWh/year

### Wind Industry Supply Chain

Arkansas is already home to 11 companies and 12 facilities that are involved in the full value chain of the wind energy industry, even though no wind farms exist in the state. Some notable examples include companies like LM Windpower, PPG Industries, and ABB.






