SERVICE FEES AND BILLING CODES

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1. PURPOSE

This Directive transmits the fee schedule and billing codes for official services performed by the Grain Inspection, Packers and Stockyards Administration, Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS), under the United States Grain Standards Act, and the Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946. Additionally, the directive transmits the fee schedule for supervision of grain inspection and weighing services applicable to official inspection agencies.

2. REPLACEMENT HIGHLIGHTS

This Directive revises the billing codes for official services performed by FGIS and revises the fee schedule for Official Inspection and Weighing Services as published in the Federal Register (78 FR 22151) on April 15, 2013 with change effective October 1, 2015.

This Directive creates unique billing codes for Commodity Inspection Services laboratory tests previously published in the Federal Register (69 FR 1893) on January 13, 2004.

This Directive supersedes FGIS Directive 9180.74, dated 10/01/2014.

3. AUTHORITIES

The United States Grain Standards Act, as amended

The Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946

Title 7, Code of Federal Regulations, Parts 800 and 868

4. POLICY

Fees assessed by FGIS for official services shall be reasonable, nondiscriminatory, and cover the estimated cost of the service. These costs include direct, administrative, and supervisory costs related to these services.

5. FEES AND BILLING CODES

The attachments transmit the fees and billing codes for official services provided by FGIS.
