January 25, 2015: The Intelligent Mail® Package Barcode (IMpb) is required for Certified Mail®, Registered Mail®, Priority Mail® and all packages.

Priority Mail® (including flat size, letter size and all weights) – in order to retain Commercial Base™ Pricing (CBP), the full IMpb requirements must be met (or retail prices apply):

- a. A unique Intelligent Mail® Package Barcode (IMpb)
- b. Shipping Services File 1.6 or higher (Pub 199)
- c. Including a correct destination delivery address or ZIP+4 Code for each package.

All packages need to meet the same requirements as outlined above (or will pay full retail pricing). For Certified Mail® and Registered Mail™ use IMpb on all sizes, weights and shapes (no price penalty). For regular mail and flats sent via First-Class Mail® or Standard Mail® no changes are required.
