



## **AVAILABLE 24 HOURS A DAY, 7 DAYS A WEEK**

To assist health care providers in ensuring every newborn is adequately screened, the Newborn Screening Program of the Oklahoma State Department of Health has established an automated Voice Response System.

- Provide your pre-assigned Submitter ID number and PIN.
- Provide the infant's filter paper serial number or Mother's Social Security number.

A screening result will be provided at the time of the call and if requested, faxed to your office.

Reminder: To prevent morbidity and mortality, all Oklahoma newborns are required to have a screening blood and hearing test. Blood screening includes congenital hypothyroidism, galactosemia, amino acid disorders including phenylketonuria (PKU), sickle cell disease, congenital adrenal hyperplasia, cystic fibrosis, fatty acid disorders including medium chain acyl CoA dehydrogenase deficiency (MCAD), organic acid disorders, and biotinidase deficiency.
