Dear Ms. Stitt:

This is in response to your letter of December 20, 1983, concerning proposed Rules and Regulations of the Department of Social Services. You specifically mentioned 474 NAC 6-021.09 entitled Discretion of the Director, and 6-021.10, entitled Failure to Safeguard and Maintain Confidentiality.

In regard to the first question, the Director of the Department of Social Services is charged with maintaining confidentiality of information regarding state wards pursuant to Neb.Rev.Stat. §§68-312 and 68-313 (1982 Supp.), §68-313.01 (1983 Supp.) and §28-713.727 (1982 Supp.). Apparently, 6-021.09 seeks to permit the Director to carry out that duty and at the same time cooperate with the Foster Care Review Board. However, a review of the applicable statutes indicates no authority for the Department of Social Services to withhold information from the Foster Care Review Board at the discretion of the Director. language of Neb.Rev.Stat. §43-1309 is clear that request of the state board or the designated local board, any records pertaining to a case assigned to such board shall be furnished to the board by the agency charged with the child." (Emphasis supplied.) In view of this language, it is our opinion that the statute does not authorize the Director to withhold information which has been requested by the Board.

Further, based on the same rationale, it is our opinion that the statute does not permit the Department to temporarily suspend the release of information to the Board as provided for in 6-021.10D.
