Staff support shall be provided by the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education, with assistance from the staffs of the Senate Transportation Committee and the House Education and Public Works Committee, upon request. Findings and recommendations shall be submitted to the General Assembly by October 31, 2016.)
