Current Situation:

Fire is currently burning in steep rugged terrain making access for fire crews difficult. Resources will continue to work thoughout the night to take advantage of cooler temperatures while additional resources continue to respond from around the State.

Evacuations:

Evacuation Advisory has been issued for The Double Eagle Ranch and homes along the highway 20 cooridor between New Long Valley Rd. and east to the county line. The evacuation center in Clear Lake has been closed. An evacuation center was opened at Middletown High School in Middletown and is better suited to handle the evacuees. Evacuations are still in effect for the area North of Morgan Valley and East of Bonham Rd, Jerusalem Grade Rd, Spruce Grove Rd (North end), Noble Ranch Rd and Cantwell Ranch Rd.
