**Remarks:**

01. Left Front has an electoral understanding with the Congress, JDU & RJD. But the seat sharing by Left Front with the Congress, fielding 92 candidates in Assembly Election, was not total. In 18 Assembly Constituencies (ACs), the Congress and one of the partners of the Left Front, both fielded candidates. The largest partner of the Left Front CPI(M), contested against the Congress, among others, in five ACs. These five ACs included 4 in Murshidabad District (Jangipur, Sagardighi, Hariharpara & Domkal) and one in Nadia District (Krishnaganj).

Another Constituent of the Left Front, RSP fielded candidates against those of the Congress, among others, in as many as 8 ACs. These eight ACs included two in Alipurduars District (Kalchini & Alipurduars), one in Maldah District (Malatipur) and five in Murshidabad District (Suti, Raghunathganj, Burwan, Bharatpur & Nowda). Another Left Front partner AIFB contested against the Congress, among others in three ACs. These included one each in Maldah District (Harischandrapur), Birbhum District (Rampurhat) and Murshidabad District (Murshidabad).

2. Although one Left Front partner fielded its candidate against the Congress, among others in Hansan AC of Birbhum District, it unofficially withdrew in favour of the INC candidate after the prescribed time for withdrawal of nomination had been over.

3. In Islampur AC of Uttar Dinajpur District, INC also fielded its candidate despite the Left Front extending its support to JDU candidate there. But the JDU candidate in Howrah Madhya (Howrah District) enjoyed support of both Left Front as well as Congress. The RJD candidate in Jorasanko AC of Kolkata North District and the NCP candidate of Tarakeswar AC of Hooghly District also got the support of both Left Front and Congress.

4. The Left Front and the Congress both supported one common Independent candidate each in seven ACs. 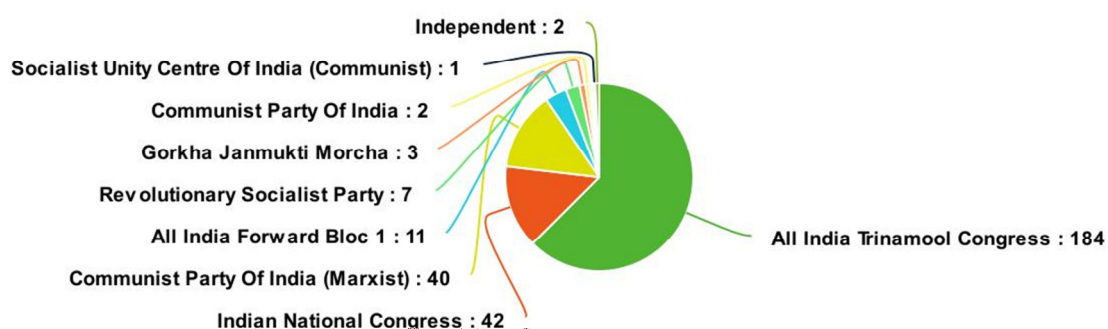
