Elevated groundwater and flooding can cause chemical contamination

Recent excessive rain in the interior has raised surface water and groundwater levels throughout the Borough.

Flooding or increased groundwater can damage underground fuel tanks and home sewage systems.

This can lead to petroleum or sewage contamination in your yard or your drinking water well.

A flooded basement or crawlspace can also bring this contamination back into the home.

Increased moisture can also grow mold, damage the structure and contaminate food.
