Outline Description Originally designed as a free-standing structure surrounded by open space, this 20th century religious modernist structure was built on designs drawn in the 1960s.

Property Description

Built in 1988, the church was dedicated to Our Lady of Mount Carmel on 1 February 1990. The church is built in a modern style. The ceiling is supported at four points to provide a symmetrical cross design whilst across both axes retaining the square plan of the church at its base. Designed by architect Victor Muscat Inglott and structural engineer Godfrey Azzopardi in the 1960s, the church was designed to be appreciated

as a free-standing structure surrounded by open space.


