- »DRAGON TROPHY« for categories Advanced Novices (boys, girls), Juniors (Men, Ladies) and Senior Ladies in Short Program and Free Skating (International Junior and Novice competition)
- »TIVOLI CUP« for boys and girls in categories Chicks, Cubs, Springs and Debs in Free Skating only (Interclub competition)

Location of competition:	Hala Tivoli, Celovška 25, 1000 Ljubljana (covered and heated Ice Rink, 60x30m, capacity 6000 spectators, located 500 m from the center of Ljubljana)		
Entries:	»DRAGON TROPHY« Each National Figure Skating Federation associated in I.S.U., may enter 2 competitors (2 Men (Boys) and 2 Ladies (Girls)) in Novice and Junior categories and 1 Man and 1 Lady for Senior category. The Organizer reserves the right to enter more competitors in each category.		
	»TIVOLI CUP « Each Club (member of I.S.U. Member Federation), may enter 2 competitors (2 girls and 2 boys) in each category. The Organizer reserves the right to enter more competitors in each category.		
Deadline for entries:	The entries should arrive at The Slovene Skating Union, and the Organizer should receive the copies not later than on January 15, 2012.

Charges:		For »DRAGON TROPHY« and »TIVOLI CUP« a fee of 40 EUR is to be paid for each competitor. Cancelation of the competitor entry, if any, have to be done till January 28, 2012 . For any later cancelation the team leader of federation or club will be asked to pay the entry fee.			
Judges:		Each participating National Figure Skating Federation or club may nominate one International or Championships Judge for the »DRAGON TROPHY«, who will be able to judge one to two categories at the »TIVOLI CUP«, if needed. Clubs may nominate one, at least National Judge, just for the »TIVOLI CUP«. In case of too many nominated judges, the organizer will draw the panels of judges after the entries closing date and a written confirmation will immediately be sent to each federation/club.			
Responsibilities:		In accordance with the I.S.U. Regulations, Rule 119, all participants act on their own responsibility. The organizer will provide medical emergency aid during competition and practice.

CATEGORIES:

I. »DRAGON TROPHY«

- A. **SENIOR** Men and Ladies: according to ISU Regulations Figure Skating 2010
- B. JUNIOR Men and Ladies: according to ISU Regulations Figure Skating 2010
- C. <u>ADVANCE NOVICE boys and girls, born between July 1st,1996 and June 30th, 2001: according to ISU Communication No.1649 for singles:</u>

Short Program of a maximum duration 2:30 minutes.

- i. Novice Girls:
 - a. Axel Paulsen or double Axel Paulsen
 - b. Double or triple jump immediately preceded by connecting steps not repeat jump in a)
 - c. One jump combination consisting of two double jumps or one double and one triple jump, both jumps may not repeat jump in a) or b)
 - d. Layback or sideways leaning spin (minimum of six (6) revolutions)
 - e. Spin combination with only one change of foot and at least one change of position (minimum of five (5) revolutions on each foot).
 - f. One step sequence with full utilization of the ice surface (straight line, serpentine or circular).
- ii. Novice Boys:
 - a. Axel Paulsen or double Axel Paulsen
 - b. Double or triple jump immediately preceded by connecting steps not repeat jump in a)
 - c. One jump combination consisting of two double jumps or one double and one triple jump, both jumps may not repeat jump in a) or b)
 - d. Camel or sit spin (minimum of six (6) revolutions). Change of foot is optional. No flying entrance.
 - e. Spin combination with only one change of foot and at least one change of position (minimum of five (5) revolutions on each foot).
 - f. One step sequence of different nature with full utilization of the ice surface (straight line, serpentine or circular).

Free Skating Program of 3:00 minutes (+ or - 10 seconds) for Girls and 3:30 minutes (+ or - 10 seconds) for Boys.

A well balanced Free Skating program for Singles must contain:

- Maximum of 6 jump elements for Girls and maximum of 7 jump elements for Boys one of which must be an Axel type jump and there may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted. Only two (2) jumps with two and a half (2 ½) or three (3) revolutions can be repeated either in a jump combination or jump sequence.
- b. There must be maximum (2) spins of a different nature, one of which must be a spin combination (total of ten (10) revolutions minimum) and one a flying spin or spin with flying entrance (minimum of six (6) revolutions).
- c. There must be a maximum of one (1) step sequence

Levels explanations:

For Advanced Novice Singles, in all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to **Level 3** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Transitions
- Performance/Execution
- Interpretation

The factors for the Program Components is

- a) Short Program
 - for boys 1.0.
 - for girls 1.0
- b) Free Skating
 - for boys 1.7
 - for girls 1.5

The same ISU Rules regarding judging, refereeing and the work of the Technical Panel apply as in Junior and Senior International Competitions.

II. »TIVOLI CUP«

DEBS: Born in 1998 or younger – only free skating:

Girls: 3 min +/- 10 sec

Boys: 3 min 30 sec +/- 10 sec

A well balanced Free Skating program for Singles must contain:

- Maximum of 6 jump elements for Girls and maximum of 7 jump elements for Boys one of which must be an Axel type jump and there may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted. Only two (2) jumps with two and a half (2 ½) or three (3) revolutions can be repeated either in a jump combination or jump sequence.
- b. There must be maximum (2) spins of a different nature, one of which must be a spin combination (total of ten (10) revolutions minimum) and one a flying spin or spin with flying entrance (minimum of six (6) revolutions).
- c. There must be a maximum of one (1) step sequence

Levels explanations:

For Debs in all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to **Level 3** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Transitions
- Performance/Execution
- Interpretation

The factors for the Program Components is

- Free Skating
- for boys 1.7
- for girls 1.5

The same ISU Rules regarding judging, refereeing and the work of the Technical Panel apply as in Junior and Senior International Competitions.

SPRINGS: Born in 2000 or younger – free skating only

Girls: 2 min 30 sec +/- 10 sec Boys:3 min +/- 10 sec

A well balanced Free Skating program for Singles must contain:

- a. Maximum of 5 jump elements for Girls and maximum of 6 jump elements for Boys one of which must be an Axel type jump and there may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted.
- b. There must be maximum (2) spins of a different nature, one of which must be a spin combination (total of ten (10) revolutions minimum) and one a flying spin (without change of foot and position) or spin in one position (with or without change of foot) (minimum of five (5) revolutions).
- c. There must be a maximum of one (1) step sequence

Levels explanations:

For Springs in all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to **Level 3** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Transitions
- Performance/Execution
- Interpretation

The factors for the Program Components is

- Free Skating
- for boys 1.7
- for girls 1.5

The same ISU Rules regarding judging, refereeing and the work of the Technical Panel apply as in Junior and Senior International Competitions.

CUBS:

Born in 2002 or younger – free skating only

Girls: 2 min +/- 10 sec

Boys:2 min 30 sec +/- 10 sec

A well balanced Free Skating program for Singles must contain:

- a. Maximum of 5 jump elements for Girls and maximum of 6 jump elements for Boys one of which must be an Axel type jump and there may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted.
- b. There must be maximum (2) spins of a different nature, one of which must be a spin combination (with or without change of foot) and one spin in one position (with or without change of foot).
- c. There must be a maximum of one (1) step sequence utilization 2/3 of the ice surface AND one (1) spiral of 3 seconds.

Levels explanations:

For Cubs in all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution

Interpretation
 The factors for the Program Components is

 Free Skating
 for boys 2.0
 for girls 1.7

The same ISU Rules regarding judging, refereeing and the work of the Technical Panel apply as in Junior and Senior International Competitions.

CHICKS: Born in 2004 or younger – free skating only Girls: 2 min +/- 10 sec Boys: 2 min +/- 10 sec

A well balanced Free Skating program for Singles must contain:

- a. Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and maximum of 5 jump elements for Boys and there may be up to one (1) jump combination or sequence. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted.
- b. There must be maximum (2) spins, one of which must be spin in one position without change of foot (minimum of three (3) revolutions), type of second spin is optional.
- c. There must be a maximum of one (1) spiral sequence of two (2) spirals each on different foot and duration of 2 seconds.

Levels explanations:

For Chicks, in all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution

The factors for the Program Components is

Free Skating

- for boys and girls 2.5

The same ISU Rules regarding judging, refereeing and the work of the Technical Panel apply as in Junior and Senior International Competitions.
