Columbia City Station

Columbia City Station was part of building Central Link. It is a street-level station with side platforms in the center of Martin Luther King Jr. Way South. Patrons can access the station from South Alaska or South Edmunds streets by crosswalk. Pedestrian street improvements along South Edmunds Street enhance the connection to Columbia City. The plaza at the northeast corner of Edmunds and Martin Luther King Jr. Way South has amenities such as landscaping, public art, seating, bicycle parking and lighting.
