We, the undersigned, constituting the State Board of Canvassers met in the office of the Secretary of State on December 15, 1989, for the purpose of canvassing the votes of the Special Election held December 5, 1989, and we hereby certify that the following abstract shows number of votes cast for the Constitutional Measure and Referred Measures and is a correct abstract as the same has been duly certified to us by the various County Auditors of the State and we do hereby certify that the Constitutional Measure (Amendment) and Referred Measures were approved as shown herein.

No. 3 provides for an increase in motor fuel tax. No. 4 provides for an increase in the state sales tax. No. 5 provides for the mandatory use of seat belts. No. 6 provides for the use of electronic video gaming devices. No. 7 provides for an increase in state income tax. No. 8 provides for a comprehensive health care education program in each school district.
