**Meeting of State Canvassing Board**

After each election, the Secretary of State's office provides the state and federal court system with a list of individuals recorded in the poll book within a county that voted. This task was completed this past January.

Subsequently, personnel in the federal court system happened to notice that in a few counties the list of individuals credited as having voted in that county did not match the vote totals posted for that county on the state's official election results page. With the exception of Walsh County, all of the differences were minor and easily identified as to the reason.

However, in the case of Walsh County, the difference was approximately 300 votes. A preliminary inquiry made by the Secretary of State's office revealed that one precinct in that county had run out of ballots and approximately 300 voters were given photocopied ballots on which to cast their votes. These ballots were hand counted and additional research appeared to indicate that those results may have been entered twice into the Election Reporting Manager.

The discrepancy between the number of ballots tabulated and the number of voters recorded in the poll book, as having voted, was not noted when the county canvassing board met after the November election to certify the county election results to the State Canvassing Board.

After several conversations between the Secretary of State's office and county officials as to the reconciliation of the numbers, the Walsh County State's Attorney advised for the reconvening of the County Canvassing Board, which was done on April 16. During a lengthy session, they re-tabulated the photocopied ballots. Then, the Board recessed to allow the County Auditor to complete the reconciliation of the numbers. The County Canvassing Board met again on April 23 to certify the new results, which did not change the outcome of any position or measure on the ballot.

On election eve, the results are transmitted electronically for all ballots that are counted by the scanning equipment. However, in this case, the photocopied ballots could not be counted on the scanning equipment and those ballots were hand counted. Those results were incorrectly entered into the reporting system. But, by doing this, it disabled the otherwise engaged verification controls, which is now known and corrective measures are being taken to make sure it does not happen again.
