Note 2: — Deed permits slope to extend not more than 4 ft. north of north line of parcel 3. The N & C St. L. Ry by deed no. 2333 dated June 26, 1905 reserved July 21, 1905, in deed book 364 p 351 R.O.S. Co. sold to the City of Memphis et al 7/8 interest in a strip of parcel 3 23.55' x 6' on the east side of Porter Street, reserving 1/8 interest in said strip.

Note 3: — Deed creates right to lease easement on lands conveyed not to extend more than 40' north from north line of Broadway. The N & C St. L. Ry by deed 2333 referred to in Note 2 conveyed 7/8 interest in a strip of parcel 4, 35' x 43' on the west side of Porter St. reserving 1/8 interest in said strip.

Note 4: — The N & C St. L. Ry conveyed 2/7 interest in parcel 9 to the Southern Ry. by deed no. 2946 dated Sept. 16, 1903 recorded Oct. 3, 1903, in DB 117 p 105 R.O.S. Co. 1/7 interest is held by the N & C St. L. Ry for itself and the remaining 4/7 interest are held in trust by the N & C St. L. Ry for the Frisco Lines and Union Ry. said parties having paid their part of the cost.

Note 5: — The Union Ry. condemned parcel 10 and billed the other railroads occupying Broadway for their share of the cost, of which the N & C St. L. Ry paid 1/7. The deed was made to the N & C St. L. Ry.
