His current research focuses on Indonesian and Malaysian development policies of the 1960s and 70s. He is Southeast Asia coordinator for Tracking Development, an international, multidisciplinary research project funded by the Netherlands Ministry of Foreign Affairs which seeks to draw policy-relevant lessons from the diverging development trajectories of Southeast Asia and Sub-Saharan Africa since 1960.
