You will be presenting the Agency Medallion to Brigadier General Richard S. Beyea Jr., commander of the Air Force Office of Special Investigations (OSI), who is retiring after 29 years of service. During an awards presentation program from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m., representatives of 14 organizations including the Immigration and Naturalization Service, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms, the Secret Service, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, and the Federal Bureau of Investigation will honor Dick Beyea. You are the final presenter and will be preceded by Buck Revell. The awards presentation program will be followed by a cocktail hour from 7 p.m. to 8 p.m., and then dinner.

In the remarks, you emphasize the excellent working relationship between the FBI and OSI, particularly in the area of counterespionage. You also mention the cooperation between the CIA and OSI in the area of counterintelligence. You conclude by referring to the number and diversity of groups which are honoring Dick Beyea at this ceremony and present him with the Agency Medallion "as a recognition of your long service to the country and in appreciation for all that you have done to promote the cooperation among us that benefits counterintelligence."
