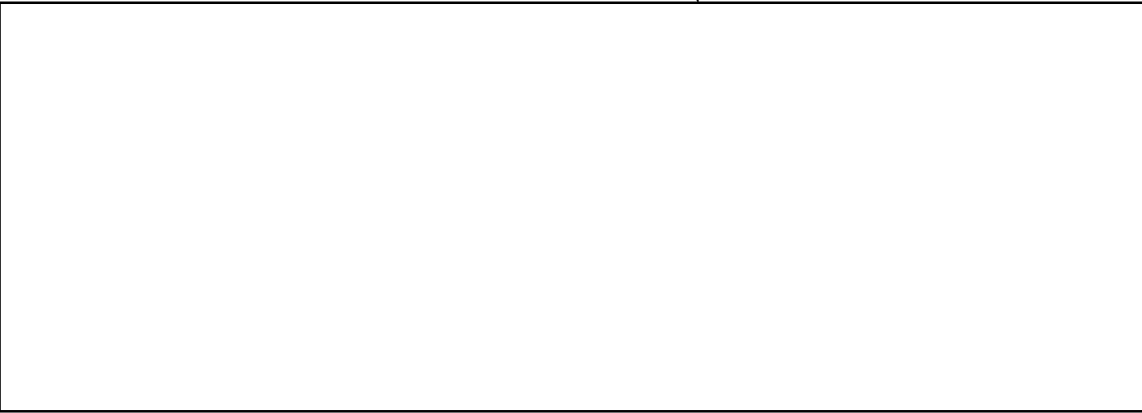

1. During the summer of 1951 the Central Artillery Depot at Timot Utca 6, Budapest, received a number of shipments of masts and equipment described as components of V-2 weapons.
2. Each of these deliveries was supervised by one Major Zavory B. Istvan, a Hungarian liaison officer to an unidentified Soviet headquarters. Major Istvan wore a Hungarian uniform, spoke fluent Russian and Hungarian with a Carpatho-Ukrainian accent. He travelled frequently to Moscow and other satellite capitals.
