TEST GUIDED MISSILES FOR ANTI-AIRCRAFT USE IN HUNGARY

Antiaircraft Shells Tested at Suttor

A new type of antiaircraft shell is being tested at the target range in Suttor [Sopron Megye]. Built according to a Soviet prototype, the shell can be guided to an enemy aircraft automatically from a distance of 120 meters [sic].

When the tests are conducted, all the barracks at Suttor are evacuated to prevent security leaks.

Barracks Built at Polgardi

Barracks which will accommodate 8,000 men have been built at Polgardi beside the existing barracks for armored troops.
