## LECHEA INTERMEDIA Leggett Round-fruited Pinweed

FAMILY: Cistaceae

- HABIT: Suffruticose or herbaceous perennial, 2-6 dm.; flowering late June-July, fruiting late July-November.
- SIMILAR SPECIES: *L. intermedia* resembles *L. leggettii. L. intermedia* has 3- sided light brown seeds covered with an off-white, reticulate membrane while the seeds of *L. leggettii* are brown and 2-sided (flattened). All members of the genus *Lechea* in Ohio are morphologically similar and technical characters are needed to distinguish the species.
- TOTAL RANGE: Cape Breton Island to Ont., MN, and ND, s. to NE, IL, WI, MI, OH, and PA, ne. to NY, VT, NH, and in the mts. to VA.
- STATE RANGE (as of 2008): Post-1980 records are known from Ashland, Holmes, Knox, Lucas, Portage, Richland, and Summit counties. Pre-1980 records are known from Lorain, Stark, and Wayne counties.
- HABITAT: Usually sunny areas in dry, sterile, acidic, sandy soil in fields, openings, and dunes.
- HAZARDS: Unknown, possibly overshading by woody species as a result of succession; or compaction of the soil by trampling.
- RECOVERY POTENTIAL: Unknown, probably good due to the widespread availability of habitat.
- INVENTORY GUIDELINES: Fruiting material and seeds are needed for accurate identification. Overwintering basal leaf shoots, produced late in the season, are helpful. Non-flowering material cannot be identified with certainty.
- COMMENTS: This species is not conspicuous and is easily misidentified. It should be sought throughout glaciated Ohio.

Some authors recognize three varieties of *L. intermedia*. If this treatment is followed, Ohio plants belong to the typical variety. However, most recent treatments consider it a single entity.
