LECHEA PULCHELLA Raf. Leggett's Pinweed

FAMILY: Cistaceae

SYNONYMS: Lechea leggettii Britt. & Holl.

HABIT: Slender stems from simple caudex, 2-8 cm; fruits and flowers July-Aug.

- SIMILAR SPECIES: All members of the genus in Ohio are very similar and difficult to identify. *L. pulchella* can be distinguished by the following combination of characters: outer sepals much shorter than the 3-nerved inner sepals, leaves with hard, shiny, conical brown tips, fruiting calyx less than 1.5 mm broad, obovoid and acute at base, and containing 2-3 seeds.
- TOTAL RANGE: MA to s. Ont. and nw. IN, s. to DE, n. VA, and OH and s. on the coastal plain to FL and LA.
- STATE RANGE (as of 2008): There are post-1980 records from Lucas, Portage, Stark, Summit and Wood counties. There are pre-1980 records from Henry, Mahoning, Ross, and Wayne counties.

HABITAT: Dry to moist sandy plains, shores, and open woods.

HAZARDS: Overgrowth by taller species as a result of succession.

RECOVERY POTENTIAL: Probably good, the species appears to respond well to disturbance and perhaps fire.

INVENTORY GUIDELINES: Collect complete fruiting specimens.

COMMENTS: This taxon was formerly known as *L. leggettii*, however an older Rafinesque name has been shown to have priority (Wilbur 1966). Ohio material may be referred to as var. *moniliformis* (Bickn.) Hodgdon.

This species should be sought throughout northern Ohio and also in Ross and adjacent counties of south-central Ohio.
