### AGREED BOARD ORDER

# AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT OF JEFFERSON COUNTY

This order is issued by the Air Pollution Control Board of Jefferson County (Board) pursuant to Kentucky Revised Statutes Chapter 77 AIR POLLUTION CONTROL.

# **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION:**

Company operates a Neoprene manufacturing facility that is subject to 40 C.F.R. Part 63, Subpart U (National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutant Emissions: Group 1 Polymers & Resins), which is incorporated by reference in District Regulation 5.02. Subpart U requires the Company to conduct a performance test to demonstrate compliance with the standard within 150 days after the compliance date. Company's performance testing was required by November 16, 2001.

In letters dated October 8, 2001 and November 12, 2001, Company notified the District that it would not be able to conduct the stack tests required by Subpart U in accordance with the specified test methods, and requested an extension of six months in order to develop alternative test methods and to conduct the tests. In a letter dated December 6, 2001, the District denied Company's request.

Company has proposed a plan to obtain the EPA's approval of alternative test methods and to conduct the required stack testing by June 30, 2002, or later, depending on the length of time required to obtain EPA's approval. If the Company has not submitted confirmation that demonstrates compliance with Subpart U by November 16, 2002, the Board shall consider further enforcement action including, but not limited to, additional administrative penalties.

To fully resolve the above-mentioned allegation of noncompliance with District Regulation 5.02, the parties agree to this Order assessing against the Company an administrative settlement of

\$11,250 and requiring the Company to implement compliance measures set forth herein. The administrative penalty must be paid by April 30, 2002.

On April 17, 2002, a public hearing was held before the Board on the proposed settlement. Based upon the evidence presented at that hearing, the Board determined that the proposed resolution and requirements were reasonable under the circumstances.

# NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Company shall pay \$11,250 to the Air Pollution Control District of Jefferson County (District) by April 30, 2002.
- 2. Company shall achieve compliance with Subpart U in accordance with the following compliance schedule:

<u>Milestone</u> <u>Completion Date</u>

Select contractor to develop modified test methods

Complete

Develop modified test methods, submit to EPA for approval

Complete

Conduct stack tests required by Subpart U

within 6 weeks after receiving approval of alternative test method from EPA

Analyze test results, submit test results to District

within 6 weeks after conducting stack tests

- 3. Company has reviewed this Order and consents to all its requirements and terms. Further, Company agrees to pay the cost of publishing legal notice on the public hearing.
- 4. Nothing herein shall be deemed to preclude Company from seeking future permit revisions for physical or operational changes at its facility consistent with District regulations.
- 5. In the event that it is necessary for the District to seek a court order to enforce this Order, Company agrees to pay filing fees and costs of any such action.
- 6. Company's obligations under this Order shall terminate upon Company's completion of all the requirements described in this Order to the satisfaction of the District. Company shall continue to comply with all District regulations after termination of this Order.

7. Neither this Order nor the actions take Company of any wrongdoing regarding any of the		•
