# John<sup>1</sup> Brown (c1602-1687) and Sarah (\_\_\_\_\_) Brown (d. 1672)

JOHN<sup>1</sup> Brown appears in Hampton, N. H., in 1639.<sup>1</sup> He married Sarah \_\_\_\_\_ probably about 1640.<sup>2</sup>

In the Hampton tax list of 1653, he paid the third largest tax.<sup>3</sup>

Sarah Brown died on 6 Jul 1672. John died on 28 Feb 1687.

John and Sarah (\_\_\_\_\_) Brown had the following children:

- i. **Sarah Brown**,<sup>4</sup> born in 1643.<sup>5</sup> She married John Poor on 13 Mar 1661<sup>6</sup> and died in Charlestown, Mass. of smallpox on 28 Dec 1678.<sup>7</sup>
- ii. John Brown,<sup>8</sup> born in 1644.<sup>9</sup> He served in King Philip's War<sup>10</sup> and died on 29 Aug 1683.<sup>11</sup>
- iii. Benjamin<sup>2</sup> Brown, <sup>12</sup> born in 1647, <sup>13</sup> q. v.
- iv. Elizabeth Brown,<sup>14</sup> born in 1650.<sup>15</sup> She married Isaac Marston of Hampton on 23 Oct 1669.<sup>16</sup>
- v. **Jacob Brown**,<sup>17</sup> born in 1653.<sup>18</sup> He married Sarah Brookin.<sup>19</sup> She was

- the daughter of William and Mary (Walford) Brookin of Portsmouth, N. H.<sup>20</sup> He died on 13 Feb 1740.<sup>21</sup>
- vi. **Mary Brown**, born on 13 Sep 1655 in Hampton<sup>22</sup>
- vii. **Thomas Brown**, born on 14 Jul 1657 in Hampton.<sup>23</sup> He married Abial Shaw.<sup>24</sup> She was the daughter of Joseph and Elizabeth (Partridge) Shaw,<sup>25</sup> q. v. He served in King Philip's War.<sup>26</sup> She died on 21 Dec 1739, aged 77,<sup>27</sup> and he died on 19 Jun 1744.<sup>28</sup>
- viii. Stephen Brown, born in 165929

### Benjamin<sup>2</sup> Brown (d. 1736) and Sarah (Brown) Brown (1658-1732)

BENJAMIN<sup>2</sup> Brown (JOHN<sup>1</sup>) was a farmer who lived in the southeastern part of Hampton, N. H., in the portion of Hampton that is now the town of Seabrook.<sup>30</sup> He fought in King Philip's War in 1675-76.<sup>31</sup>

SARAH<sup>3</sup> Brown (William<sup>2</sup> George<sup>1</sup>) was born on 12 Apr 1658 in Salisbury, Mass.<sup>32</sup>

Benjamin Brown married Sarah Brown in 1679.33

Benjamin served as a selectman from 1690 to 1701 and again in 1711, and as a representative in 1697.<sup>34</sup>

Sarah Brown died about 1730.35 Benjamin died in 1736.36

Benjamin and Sarah (Brown) Brown had the following children, all born in  ${\rm Hampton:}^{37}$ 

i. William Brown, born on 5 Jun 1680. He married Ann Heath on 9 Jun 1701. She was born in Hampton on 30 Jun 1684, the daughter of John and Sarah (Partridge) Heath. They lived in Kensington, N. H. He died in September 1725. Ann died on 7 Aug 1765.

ii. Sarah Brown, born on 11 Sep 1681,

- v. **John Brown**, born on 18 Mar 1688. He married Abigail Johnson 24 Mar 1715. They lived in Hampton Falls. He died in 1748.
- vi. **Jacob Brown**, born on 4 Mar 1691. He married (1) Mary Green in 1715, and (2) Jemima Howell in October 1737.

- He lived in Hampton Falls and died on 23 Apr 1762.
- vii. **Stephen Brown**, born on 17 Jul 1693. He married Martha Heath on 12 May 1722. He died on 1 Dec 1723.
- viii. Mary Brown, born in 1696. She married Thomas Cram and lived in Hampton Falls. She died on 31 Mar 1756.
- ix. **Thomas Brown**, born on 21 May 1699. He married Mehitabel Towle on 2 May 1729. They lived in Seabrook. He died in November 1765.
- x. **Jeremiah Brown**, born on 20 Nov 1701. He married Mary Weare on 3 Dec 1728. They lived in Seabrook. He died on 3 Dec 1728.

# Benjamin<sup>3</sup> Brown (1683-1766) and Sarah (Gove) Brown (1698-1746)

Benjamin<sup>3</sup> Brown (Benjamin<sup>2</sup> John<sup>1</sup>) was born in Hampton, N. H. on 20 Dec 1683.<sup>38</sup> Benjamin served as a soldier against the French during Queen Anne's War.<sup>39</sup>

SARAH<sup>4</sup> GOVE (EBENEEZER<sup>3</sup> EDWARD<sup>2</sup> JOHN<sup>1</sup>) was born on 3 Apr 1698.<sup>40</sup>

Benjamin Brown married Sarah Gove 6 Feb 1718.<sup>41</sup> They lived in the area that became South Hampton, N. H. in 1743.<sup>42</sup>

Sarah Brown died on 21 Aug 1746.<sup>43</sup> On 4 Dec 1749, Benjamin married Martha Walker of Seabrook, N. H.<sup>44</sup>

Benjamin Brown died on 9 Feb 1766.45

Benjamin and Sarah (Gove) Brown had the following children:<sup>46</sup>

- i. Jonathan Brown, born on 19 Sep 1718.
   He married Miriam Clough on 1 Dec 1743 and died on 27 Jan 1805
- ii. Benjamin Brown, born on 12 Oct 1720.He married Abigail Longfellow on 8Nov 1744 and died in 1807.
- iii. **Lydia Brown**, born on 28 Sep 1722. She married Moses Pike on 27 Dec 1744 and lived in Salisbury, Mass.

### Daniel<sup>4</sup> Brown (1729-1813) and Ruth (Whittier) Brown (b. 1741)

Daniel<sup>4</sup> Brown (Benjamin<sup>2-3</sup> John<sup>1</sup>) was born on 10 Nov 1729 in Kensington, N. H.<sup>47</sup>

Ruth<sup>5</sup> Whittier (Nathaniel<sup>4</sup> Reuben<sup>3</sup> Nathaniel<sup>2</sup> Thomas<sup>7</sup>) was born on 12 Mar 1741 in Salisbury, Mass., where she was baptized on 4 Jun 1741. $^{48}$ 

Daniel Brown married Ruth Whittier.<sup>49</sup> They lived in Fremont, N. H.<sup>50</sup>

Daniel Brown died on 10 May 1813.51

Daniel and Ruth (Whittier) Brown had the following children:

One source claims, without citing any proof, that he was born in London in 1589 of Scottish parents and that he was the John Brown, baker, aged 40, who sailed on the Elizabeth in 1635. [Brown, Marguerite Willette, Genealogy of John Brown of Hampton, New Hampshire (Amesbury, Mass., 1977), 1] John Brown was freed from military training in 1662, and this normally happened when a man turned 60, so it is likely that he was born about 1602
- Brown, Genealogy of John Brown of Hampton, 1, claims that she was Sarah Walker, who was also on the Elizabeth in 1635, age 17, and that they married in 1640. There was a Sarah Walker, age 17 on the Elizabeth; that she became Sarah Brown is not documented.
