

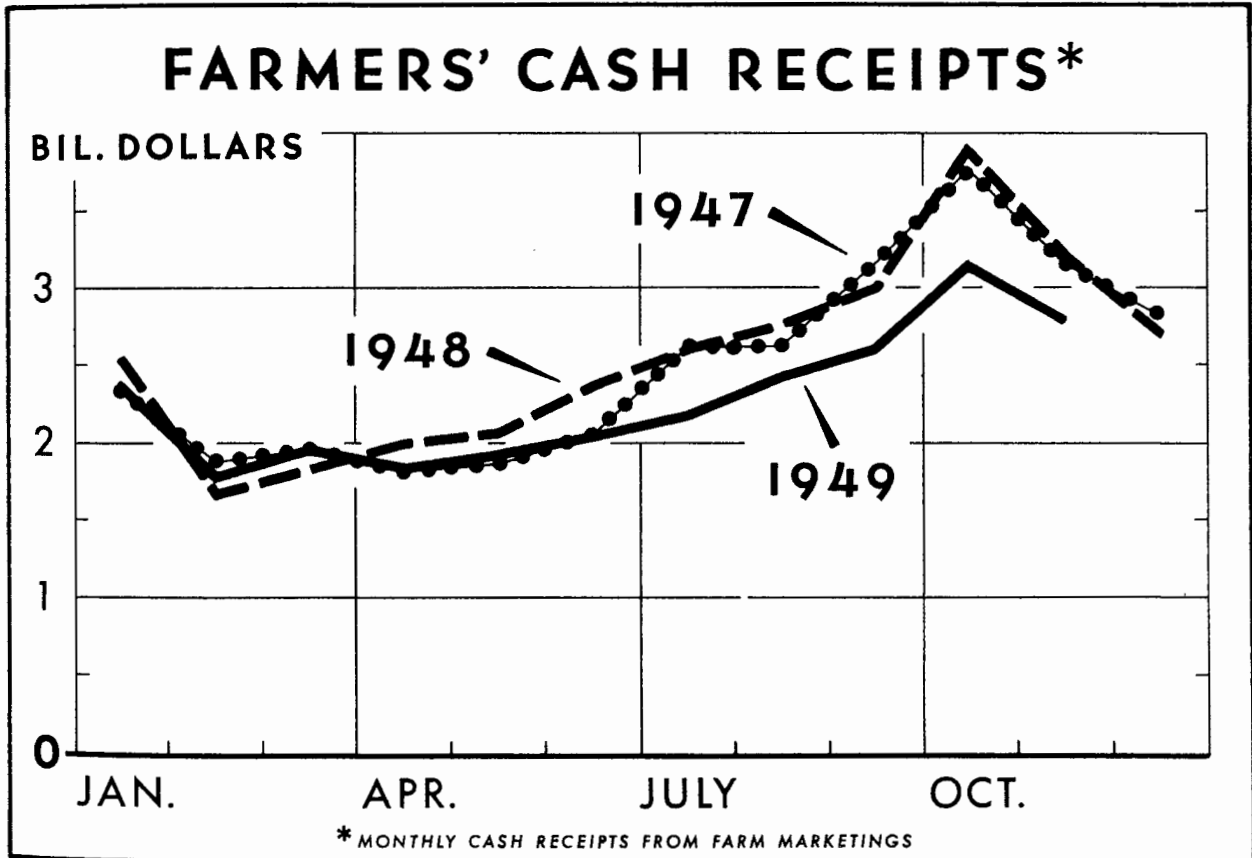

Revised monthly cash receipts, 1947



During the first quarter of the year, cash receipts in 1949 remained close to the 1948 level, as larger marketings offset lower prices.

But because of continued lower prices, receipts since March have been well below those of last year.

REVISED ESTIMATES OF CASH RECEIPTS FOR OCTOBER AND PRELIMINARY  
ESTIMATES FOR NOVEMBER AND JANUARY-NOVEMBER

Total cash receipts from farm marketings in October are now estimated at 3.1 billion dollars, 20 percent above September but 20 percent below October 1948. In November, receipts from all farm marketings are tentatively estimated at 2.8 billion dollars, 13 percent lower than in November of last year. Cumulative receipts for 1949 through November are approximately 25 billion dollars, or 10 percent below the same period in 1948.

Loans made or guaranteed by the Commodity Credit Corporation may constitute an important part of cash receipts for some crops, especially at this time of the year. Revisions in the October estimates of cash receipts have arisen mainly as a result of more up-to-date information on such loans; and the November estimates are still subject to revision on this score. The volume of crop loans to be expected is also the principal uncertainty in the way of forecasting cash receipts for December. However, it is expected that total cash receipts in December will run about 5 percent below the November level and only slightly below receipts in December a year ago.

October Receipts

In line with the new estimate of 3.1 billion dollars for total receipts from farm marketings in October, farmers received 1.3 billion dollars from the sale of livestock and livestock products and 1.8 billion dollars from crops. Cash receipts from meat animals were 11 percent greater than in September, with larger marketings more than offsetting lower prices. As compared with October of last year, marketings of meat animals were about the same, but farmers' receipts were down 17 percent because of lower prices. There were no significant changes from September in receipts from dairy products and poultry and eggs, but lower prices resulted in decreases of nearly 10 percent from October 1948 for each of these two groups.

Marketings of most crops in October were seasonally greater than in the previous month, and in spite of lower prices cash receipts from corn, cotton, and soybeans were much higher than in September. Receipts from fruits and nuts were also larger owing to increases in both marketings and prices. Compared with October 1948, however, cash receipts were down for nearly all the important crops except corn. Receipts from corn were up largely because of the delivery and sale of corn formerly held by farmers on purchase agreement contracts. Receipts from wheat were only about a third of those in October 1948 because of smaller quantities going under loan.

November Receipts

In November, farmers received about 1.3 billion dollars from livestock and products and 1.5 billion dollars from crops. The receipts from livestock and products were down about 5 percent from October, and 17 percent from November 1948. Cash receipts from meat animals were a little

lower than in October. Marketings of cattle, calves, sheep and lambs probably were down seasonally but hogs were up rather sharply. Meat-animal prices averaged slightly lower than in October. Receipts from meat animals were down substantially from a year ago, with prices and volume both lower. Dairy-product receipts were below October as the seasonal decline in marketings more than offset a slight increase in prices. Receipts from dairy products were about the same as in November 1948, as slightly larger marketings offset the decline in prices. Although sales of chickens declined in November, turkey marketings increased sharply and accounted for a moderate gain in receipts from poultry and eggs over October. Receipts were below a year ago, however, because of lower prices.

Total crop receipts in November were probably about 15 percent below October and 10 percent below November of last year. There was a seasonal drop in crop marketings of about 30 percent and a small percentage decline from November a year ago. Average crop prices were slightly above October but were 7 percent below November 1948. Receipts from corn, soybeans, tobacco, and vegetables were especially low as compared with the previous month; and receipts from nearly all crops were below last year because of lower prices.

#### January-November

From January through November of this year, farmers received about 25 billion dollars from the sale of farm products, or 10 percent less that they received in the corresponding period last year. The total volume of marketings was slightly larger than in the first 11 months of 1948, but prices received by farmers averaged 12 percent lower. Price declines averaged about the same for crops and for livestock and livestock products. Cash receipts from meat animals and dairy products were both down about 15 percent because of lower prices. But receipts from poultry and eggs were down only slightly, for larger marketings of broilers and turkeys partially offset lower prices. A substantial drop in cash receipts from wheat accounted for a large part of the decline in crop receipts for the first 11 months. Slightly smaller quantities of wheat were marketed this year at lower prices. Marketings and prices of soybeans and flaxseed were down, and total cash receipts from oil-bearing crops were considerably lower. With lower prices for truck crops and most other vegetables, receipts from vegetables were down also.
