CATTLE INVENTORY

The National Cattle and Calf inventory January 1, 1975 totaled 131.8 million head, up 3 percent from a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

The inventory this year compares with 127.7 million head January 1, 1974 and 121.5 million January 1, 1973. Although numbers continued to trend upward the increase during 1974 was less than during 1973.

A preliminary review of losses reported on recent surveys indicate that death losses were below the unusually high 1973 level, amounting to about 6.1 million head in 1974 compared to 6.5 million a year earlier. Cattle and calves slaughtered on farms was indicated at about .7 million head in 1974 compared with .5 million head in 1973. More complete disposition estimates will be published in "Meat Animals Production, Disposition and Income" to be released April 11, 1975.

This report includes the number of cattle and calves on feed as of January 1 by States and for the United States on page 11.

COWS

The inventory of cows and heifers that have calved, at 56.6 million head was up 4 percent from last year and currently represents 43 percent of all cattle and calves. Beef cows numbered 45.4 million head, up 6 percent while milk cows at 11.2 million head continued down, off 1 percent--registering a smaller decline than in recent years.

OTHER CLASSES

All heifers weighing 500 pounds and over were 19.5 million head, up 3 percent from a year ago.

Beef replacement heifers at 8.9 million head were up 8 percent; milk replacement heifers totaled 4.1 million head, up 4 percent; and, "other" heifers amounted to 6.5 million head, off 5 percent from January 1, 1974. Included in this "other" group were 2.2 million head in feedlots in the 23 major feeding States.

Bulls weighing 500 pounds and over at 3.0 million head were 13 percent above last year.

Steers weighing 500 pounds and over totaled 16.4 million head, off 8 percent from the previous year's total of 17.8 million head. The January 1, 1975 total included 6.4 million steers weighing 500 pounds and over on feed in the 23 major cattle feeding States. The inventory on January 1, 1975 of all heifers, steers, and bull calves under 500 pounds was 36.3 million head, up 7 percent from a year earlier. The number of calves under 500 pounds on feed January 1, 1975 in the 23 States included in the above total was 947,000 head.

Imports of cattle and calves, mostly from Canada and Mexico, totaled 568,271 in 1974, down 45 percent from the 1,038,985 imported during 1973. Exports during 1974 totaled 204,379 compared to 272,581 exported the previous year.

CALF CROP: The 1974 calf crop is estimated at a record high 50.8 million, 3 percent more than the 49.1 million in 1973.
