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PRODUCTION OF MANUFACTURED DAIRY PRODUCTS, UNITED STATES, 1974

BUTTER PRODUCTION ABOVE YEAR EARLIER

Production of butter in the United States during 1974 totaled 962 million pounds, 5 percent above last year's record low. Minnesota continued as the Nation's largest butter producing State with 24 percent of the total, followed by Wisconsin with 20 percent.

CHEESE OUTPUT SETS RECORD

Total cheese production, excluding cottage cheese, was at a record 2,930 million pounds, 9 percent above the previous high in 1973 and double the level of only 15 years ago. Production of all types increased except Part Skim, Limburger, Neufchatel, and Blue. Wisconsin led all States, producing 39 percent of the National total.

Production of American types of cheese totaled a record 1,859 million pounds, 11 percent above the previous high of last year. American types (Cheddar, Colby, Washed curd, Stirred curd, Monterey and Jack) made up 63 percent of the Nation's total cheese output. Cheddar at 1,402 million pounds was up 7 percent from 1973. All other American Types totaled 457 million pounds, an increase of 25 percent from a year earlier.

Output of Italian Types of cheese in 1974 set a new high of 606 million pounds, up 7 percent from the 1973 record production. Soft varieties of Italian cheese at 473 million pounds were 5 percent above the previous year and accounted for 78 percent of the total production. Mozzarella and similar types accounted for most of the soft production. Total hard varieties were 17 percent above the previous year.

Swiss cheese production at 176 million pounds was up 7 percent from 1973 and the second largest of record, falling 1 percent short of the all-time high set in 1972. Production of Cream cheese reached a new high of 147 million pounds, 8 percent above 1973. Munster cheese at 49 million pounds was 6 percent above last year while Brick cheese at 24 million pounds was 2 percent above the previous year. Blue cheese at 28 million pounds was 5 percent below 1973.

COTTAGE CHEESE PRODUCTION DECLINES

Creamed cottage cheese production in 1974 was 855 million pounds, a drop of 11 percent from 1973. Production of Lowfat Cottage cheese amounted to 122 million pounds, 5 percent below the previous year.

TOTAL FROZEN DAIRY PRODUCTS UNCHANGED

Frozen dairy products (ice cream, ice milk, milk sherbet, mellorine and other products) totaled 1,169 million gallons in 1974, virtually unchanged from last year's record high.

Total Ice Cream production in 1974 reached a record high 782 million gallons, 1 percent above 1973. Ice cream accounted for 67 percent of all frozen products, up 1 point from last year. California was the top ice cream producing State, followed by Pennsylvania.

Ice Milk production--although only slightly higher than in 1973--rose for the thirtieth consecutive year to a record 292 million gallons.

Production of Milk Sherbet was 50 million gallons in 1974, a drop of 6 percent from 1973.

Mellorine in 1974 totaled 35 million gallons, a drop of 12 percent from 1973 and it was the sixth consecutive year of lower production. Included in mellorine are all frozen products made with fats and oils other than milkfat.

The output of ice cream, ice milk, milk sherbet and mellorine sold as soft products totaled 207 million gallons in 1974, about 18 percent of the total frozen products. Ice milk made up the major share of the soft products total with 82 percent; ice cream, 13 percent; mellorine, 4 percent; and milk sherbet, 1 percent. Soft frozen dairy products are those sold from direct-serve soft freezers and milk shake machines.

DRY PRODUCTS-NONFAT AND WHEY HIGHER

Production of Nonfat dry milk for human food was 1,020 million pounds, an increase of 11 percent from the previous year. Dry Skim milk for animal feed at 5.6 million pounds was 42 percent below 1973.

Dry Whole milk production during 1974 was 68 million pounds, 13 percent below 1973.

Production of Dry Buttermilk was 45 million pounds, up 5 percent from 1973.

Total Dry Whey production set a record high with 851 million pounds in 1974, a gain of 10 percent from the previous high of last year. Dry whey for human food totaled 453 million pounds, 18 percent above 1973 and dry whey for animal feed was 399 million pounds, up 3 percent from a year earlier.

CONDENSED PRODUCTION LOWER

Production of Canned Evaporated and Condensed whole milk totaled 1,035 million pounds, down 6 percent from 1973. Bulk production of Sweetened Condensed whole milk was 69 million pounds, 10 percent below 1973. Bulk production of Unsweetened Condensed whole milk at 182 million pounds was 14 percent higher than in 1973.

Bulk output of Sweetened Condensed skim milk was 44 million pounds, down 38 percent from the previous year. Bulk Unsweetened Condensed skim milk was 669 million pounds, 17 percent below 1973.

Production of Condensed Whey (wet basis) during 1974 totaled 152 million pounds, 12 percent below the 1973 revised output.

PROCESSED CHEESE PRODUCTION INCREASES

Production of processed cheese, cheese foods, spreads and cold pack totaled 1,370 million pounds, a 7 percent increase from 1973. Processed Cheese at 746 million pounds showed a 5 percent increase from the previous year. Processed Cheese Foods and Spreads totaled 593 million pounds and Cold Pack and Cheese Foods production amounted to 31 million pounds.

WHOLE MILK USED FOR DAIRY PRODUCTS

Manufactured dairy products utilized 53 percent of the 1974 United States milk production, 2 percentage points more than the previous year. Manufacturing use, in whole milk equivalent based on milkfat content, was 61.2 billion pounds, up 4 percent from 1973.

Whole milk used for cheese production, excluding creamed cottage cheese, amounted to 25.6 billion pounds, an increase of 9 percent over 1973 and accounted for 39 percent of all milk used for manufactured dairy products. This was the second consecutive year on record that milk used for cheese exceeded that used for butter. American-type cheese used about 18.6 billion pounds of whole milk, an increase of 11 percent over 1973. Other types of cheese used 7.1 billion pounds, up 3 percent from 1973. Evaporated and condensed whole milk case goods required 2.2 billion pounds, bulk condensed milk products required 0.6 billion pounds, and dry whole milk 0.5 billion pounds.

Whole milk for butter production in 1974 was 4 percent above the previous year. A total of 19.3 billion pounds was used (excluding butter made from whey cream). Butter accounted for 33 percent of total whole milk for all products.

Frozen Dairy products used 13.2 billion pounds of whole milk equivalent, up almost 1 percent from the previous year and amounted to 20 percent of the total used for all products.
