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PRODUCTION OF MANUFACTURED DAIRY PRODUCTS, UNITED STATES, 1975

BUTTER PRODUCTION HIGHER IN 1975

Butter production in the United States during 1975 was 980 million pounds, 2 percent above 1974. Minnesota continued as the largest butter producing State with 22.2 percent of the total, followed closely by Wisconsin with 21.9 percent.

CHEESE OUTPUT SECOND LARGEST ON RECORD

Total cheese production, excluding cottage cheese, was 2,811 million pounds. This was the second largest output ever recorded, exceeded only by the 1974 record high of 2,937 million pounds. The decline in total cheese production from 1974 to 1975 was 4 percent, but all types of cheese did not follow this trend. Increases were recorded for Blue, Cream, Italian, Munster, Neufchatel, and Part Skim. Wisconsin produced 39 percent of the National total.

Largely responsible for the decline in total cheese output were the American varieties, down 11 percent from 1974. Production of all American varieties was 1,654 million pounds, 59 percent of the Nation's total cheese output. Cheddar at 1,205 million pounds decreased 14 percent. Other American varieties, with a production of 450 million pounds, were down only 2 percent. Limburger, Brick, and Swiss also registered decreases.

Total Italian varieties set a new high of 672 million pounds in 1975, 11 percent above 1974. This was the 24th year in succession that the production of Italian cheese increased over the preceding year. Soft varieties of Italian cheese at 542 million pounds were 15 percent above the previous year and accounted for 81 percent of the total Italian production. Total hard varieties, contrary to the trend for soft varieties, were down 2 percent from last year.

COTTAGE CHEESE PRODUCTION SHOWS SLIGHT INCREASE

Creamed cottage cheese production in 1975 was 862 million pounds, an increase of nearly 1 percent from 1974. Lowfat cottage cheese production at 129 million pounds increased 6 percent.

TOTAL FROZEN DAIRY PRODUCTS HIGHER

Frozen dairy products (ice cream, ice milk, milk sherbet, mellorine, and "other") totaled 1,217 million gallons in 1975, up 4 percent from the record high of 1974.

Ice Cream production in 1975 reached a new high of 833 million gallons, 7 percent over the 1974 record output. Ice Milk production at 295 million gallons declined slightly from 1974 and Milk Sherbet production of 48 million gallons decreased 4 percent. Mellorine at 30 million gallons dropped 13 percent, the seventh consecutive year of lower production.

The output of ice cream, ice milk, milk sherbet and mellorine sold as soft products totaled 224 million gallons in 1975, about 19 percent of the total frozen products. Ice milk made up the major share of the soft products total with 81 percent; ice cream, 15 percent; mellorine, 3 percent; and milk sherbet, 1 percent. Soft frozen dairy products are those sold from direct-serve soft freezers and milk shake machines.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS MOSTLY LOWER

Production of Nonfat Dry Milk for human food was 994 million pounds, down 2 percent from 1974. Dry Skim Milk for animal feed at 7 million pounds increased 28 percent. Production of Dry Whole Milk at 63 million decreased 7 percent. Dry Buttermilk at 43 million pounds decreased 5 percent from a year earlier.

NEW SERIES OF WHEY AND MODIFIED WHEY PRODUCTS

A new series of production data for condensed whey and dry whey products starting January 1975 appear in this report. Data for these new products are included in Table 4 on Pages 10-11. The series of condensed whey production, formerly reported on a wet basis, was discontinued December 1974. Condensed whey data for 1975 are in terms of pounds of solids content.

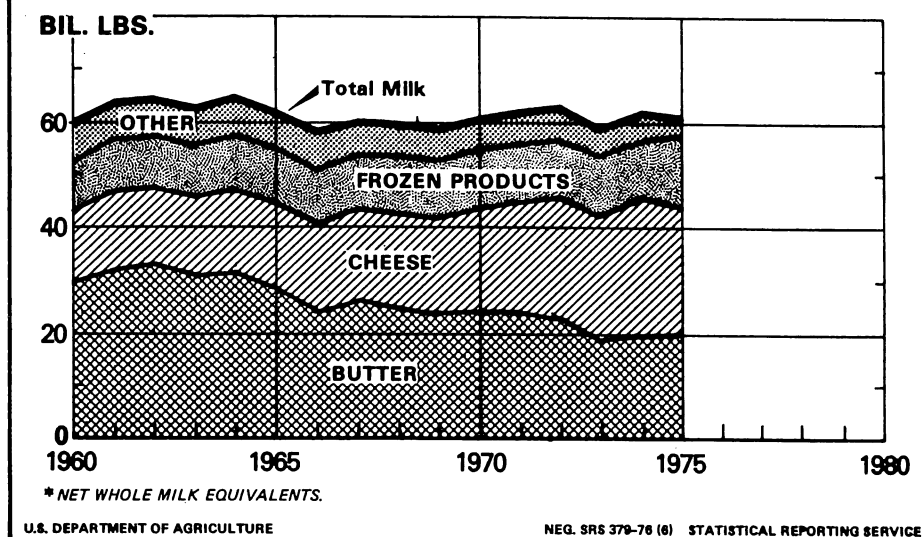
WHOLE MILK USED FOR DAIRY PRODUCTS - CURRENT YEAR

Manufactured dairy products utilized 52 percent of the 1975 United States milk production, 1 percentage point less than the previous year. Manufacturing use, in whole milk equivalent based on milkfat content, was 60.3 billion pounds, down 2 percent from 1974.

Whole milk used for cheese production, excluding creamed cottage cheese, amounted to 23.9 billion pounds, a decrease of 7 percent from 1974. Whole milk utilized for cheese production accounted for 40 percent of all milk used for manufactured dairy products.

Whole milk for butter production in 1975 was about 3 percent above the previous year. A total of 19.8 billion pounds was utilized (excluding butter made from whey cream). Butter accounted for 33 percent of total whole milk for all products.

A historical review of whole milk used in manufactured dairy products is shown in the above chart. Milk utilized for butter varied from 33 billion pounds in 1962 to a low of 18.6 billion pounds in 1973. An increasing volume of milk moved into cheese production, from about 13.4 billion pounds in 1960 to 25.6 billion pounds in 1974. Milk for cheese surpassed utilization for butter for the first time in history during 1973. Milk for frozen dairy products rose in most years from 1960 to 1975 while other utilization (dry whole, condensed and evaporated milk and other products) trended lower. The combined utilization of milk for frozen and other products varied only slightly during the 1960-75 period.

MILK USED FOR MANUFACTURED DAIRY PRODUCTS AS PERCENT OF TOTAL MILK MARKETED, 1960-1975.

Whole milk (net whole milk equivalents) utilized for manufactured dairy products tended to follow changes in total marketings of milk and cream by producers during the 1960-75 period. The percentage of marketings utilized for dairy products held in a rather narrow range, from a low of 50.6 percent in 1966 to a high of 54.6 percent in 1974.
