HOP INVENTORY

There were 34.4 million pounds (15.6 thousand metric tons) of hops held by growers, dealers and brewers on September 1, 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 5 percent above a year ago which was the lowest September 1 stocks since 1973. Hops production in 1980 increased 38 percent from 1979 to 75.6 million pounds (34.3 thousand metric tons).

Brewers' stocks accounted for 32.2 million pounds, or 94 percent of the total. This inventory is 3 percent above a year earlier but 9 percent less than on September 1, 1979. Dealers held 1.95 million pounds, compared with 1.38 million pounds on hand last year.
