## HOP INVENTORY

There were 47.0 million pounds (21.3 thousand metric tons) of hops held by growers, dealers and brewers on September 1, 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 37 percent above a year ago. Hops production in 1981 increased 5 percent from 1980 to 79.1 million pounds (35.9 thousand metric tons), setting a new record for production.

Brewers' stocks accounted for 43.7 million pounds, or 93 percent of the total. This inventory is 36 percent above a year earlier and 39 percent more than on September 1, 1980. Dealers held 2.09 million pounds, compared with 1.95 million pounds on hand last year. Growers held 1.20 million pounds, up substantially from 240 thousand pounds in 1981.
