HOP INVENTORY

There were 73.3 million pounds (33.3 thousand metric tons) of hops held by growers, dealers and brewers on March 1, 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 2 percent above a year ago. Hops production in 1982 decreased 1 percent from 1981 to 78.6 million pounds (35.6 thousand metric tons).

Brewers' stocks accounted for 55.1 million pounds, or 75 percent of the total. This inventory is 2 percent above a year earlier and 10 percent more than on March 1, 1981. Dealers held 16.7 million pounds, compared with 16.0 million pounds on hand last year. Growers held 1.60 million pounds, up 14 percent from 1.40 million pounds in 1982.
