HOP INVENTORY

There were 52.1 million pounds (23.6 thousand metric tons) of hops held by growers, dealers and brewers on September 1, 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 11 percent above a year ago. Hops production in 1982 decreased 1 percent from 1981 to 78.6 million pounds (35.6 thousand metric tons).

Brewers' stocks accounted for 47.7 million pounds, or 92 percent of the total. This inventory is 9 percent above a year earlier and 48 percent more than on September 1, 1981. Dealers held 3.00 million pounds, compared with 2.09 million pounds on hand last year. Growers held 1.38 million pounds, up 15 percent from 1982.
