HOP INVENTORY

There were 70.6 million pounds (32.0 thousand metric tons) of hops held by growers, dealers and brewers on September 1, 1987, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. This is fractionally, below a year ago. Hops production in 1986 decreased 2 percent from 1985 to 49.0 million pounds (22.2 thousand metric tons).

Brewers' stocks accounted for 62.4 million pounds, or 88 percent of the total. This inventory is 3 percent above a year earlier and 7 percent more than on September 1, 1985. Dealers held 6.58 million pounds, compared with 8.93 million pounds on hand last year. Growers held 1.62 million pounds, up 17 percent from 1986.
