HOP INVENTORY

There were 51.9 million pounds of hops held by growers, dealers, and brewers on September 1, 1990, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. This is fractionally above a year ago. Hop production, in 1989, increased 8 percent from 1988 to 59.3 million pounds.

Brewers' stocks accounted for 46.8 million pounds, or 90 percent of the total. This inventory is 8 percent more than a year earlier but 5 percent less than September 1, 1988. Dealers and growers held 5.08 million pounds, compared with 8.50 million pounds on hand last year.
