## HOP INVENTORY

There were 75.3 million pounds of hops held by growers, dealers, and brewers on March 1, 1991, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. This is 2 percent less than a year ago. Hop production, in 1990, decreased 4 percent from 1989 to 56.9 million pounds.

Brewers' stocks accounted for 57.0 million pounds, or 76 percent of the total. This inventory is 2 percent less than a year earlier but 1 percent more than March 1, 1989. Dealers and growers held 18.4 million pounds, compared with 18.8 million pounds on hand last year.
