## Hop Inventory Up

There were 54.2 million pounds of hops held by growers, dealers, and brewers on September 1, 1991. This amount is 4 percent more than a year ago. Hop production, in 1990, decreased 4 percent from 1989 to 56.9 million pounds.

Brewers' stocks accounted for 45.2 million pounds, or 83 percent of the total. This inventory is 3 percent less than a year earlier but 5 percent more than September 1, 1989. Dealers and growers held 9.00 million pounds, compared with 5.08 million pounds on hand last year.
