## Hop Inventory Up

There were 56.3 million pounds of hops held by growers, dealers, and brewers on September 1, 1992. This is 4 percent more than was on hand a year ago. Hop production, in 1991, increased 22 percent from 1990 to 69.2 million pounds.

Brewers' stocks accounted for 46.3 million pounds, or 82 percent of the total. This was 2 percent more than last September 1 but 1 percent less than in 1990. Dealers and growers held 9.98 million pounds, compared with 9.00 million pounds a year ago.
