Hop Inventory Up 3 Percent

The inventory of hops held by growers, dealers, and brewers on September 1, 1993, totaled 58.1 million pounds, 3 percent above the amount on hand September 1, 1992. Hop production for 1992, at 74.3 million pounds, climbed 7 percent above a year earlier.

Brewers' stocks accounted for 45.5 million pounds, 78 percent of the total. Brewers' held 2 percent less than they did a year earlier but 1 percent more than the amount on hand in 1991. Dealers and growers stored 12.5 million pounds this year, compared with 9.98 million pounds a year ago.
