Hop Inventory Up 10 Percent

The inventory of hops held by growers, dealers, and brewers on March 1, 1994, totaled 90.9 million pounds, 10 percent above the amount on hand March 1, 1993. Hop production in 1993, at 76.1 million pounds was, 2 percent greater than 1992.

Brewers stocks accounted for 58.2 million pounds, 64 percent of the total. Brewers' held 4 percent more than a year earlier and 5 percent more than the amount on hand in 1992. Dealers and growers stored 32.7 million pounds this year, compared with 27.2 million pounds a year ago.
