Hop Inventory Up 9 Percent

The inventory of hops held by growers, dealers, and brewers on September 1, 1994, totaled 63.0 million pounds, 9 percent above the amount on hand September 1, 1993. Hop production in 1993, at 76.1 million pounds, was 2 percent greater than in 1992.

Brewers stocks accounted for 47.1 million pounds, 75 percent of the total. Brewers' held 3 percent more than a year earlier and 2 percent more than the amount on hand in 1992. Dealers and growers stored 15.9 million pounds this year, compared with 12.5 million pounds a year ago.
