LOOKING UPON THE YEAR AS A WHILE, EXPORTS

FOR THE FIRST EIGHT MONTHS OF 1923 OF AROUND 110,000,000 POUNDS ARE STILL SOME
28,000,000 POUNDS SHORT OF LAST YEAR'S EXT APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN DONE ON A CONSERVATIVE PORTS DURING THE SIMILAR PERIOD. FOLLOWING BASIS, CLEAR FROM THE MANUFACTURER TO THE THE DISASTER IN JAPAN IT WAS EXPECTED THAT SOME GOODS MIGHT MOVE FOR RELIEF PURPOSES, ALTHOUGH SO FAR NOTHING IN THE NATURE OF BIG ORDERS APPEAR TO HAVE BEEN CONSUMATED A FEW MANUFACTURERS REPORTED A SLIGHT EX-PORT INQUIRY DURING THE LAST WEEK OR SO, THE FIRST SIGN OF INTEREST FROM THIS IT IS REPORT-SOURCE FOR SEVERAL MONTHS. ED THAT SOME SHIPMENTS ARE TO BE MADE TO GERMANY ALTHOUGH QUANTITIES ARE NOT KNOWN.
