CANNED MILK STOCKS INCREASE RAPIDLY - PRODUCTION HEAVY

A MONTH AGO IT WAS SAID THAT THE OUTSTANDING FEATURE OF THE CONDENSED AND EVAPORATED MILK MARKETS WAS THE FACT THAT STOCKS IN MANUFACTURERS! HANDS WERE THE LOWEST ON RECORD FOR JUNE I, AND WERE MATERIALLY LOWER THAN THE FIVE-YEAR AVERAGE FOR THAT DATE. BY THE END OF JUNE THIS SITUATION HAD UNDERGONE A VERY MARKED CHANGE AND A SIGNIFICANT ONE. FOR STOCKS ON JULY I, INSTEAD OF BEING LOW, WERE THE HIGHEST, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF 1924, OF ANY YEAR SINCE 1920 WHEN THESE FIGURES WERE FIRST AVAILABLE. THE FIVE-YEAR AVERAGE FOR JULY WAS EXCEEDED BY 13,000,000 POUNDS. JULY I STOCKS THIS YEAR WERE 229,433,114 POUNDS, LAST YEAR WAS 228,115,590 POUNDS, AND THE FIVE-YEAR AVERAGE FOR JULY I, 216,392,062 POUNDS.

THIS IS A MARKED CHANGE TO OCCUR IN A SINGLE MONTH AND IS, OF COURSE, EXPLAINED ONLY BY A HEAVY PRODUCTION OR LIGHT DEMAND, OR BOTH. IN THIS CASE THE FORMER WAS THE IMPORTANT FACTOR, ALTHOUGH THE LATTER ALSO ENTERED INTO THE QUESTION TO SOME DEGREE. PRODUCTION IN JUNE WAS REPORTED AS ABOUT 20% HEAVIER THAN IN JUNE 1926. IN FACT THE JUNE OUTPUT, 221,782,057 POUNDS IS THE LARGEST FOR ANY ONE MONTH ON RECORD. OF COURSE THIS COULD ONLY BE BROUGHT ABOUT UNDER FAVORABLE PRODUCTION CONDITIONS.

DURING A CONSIDERABLE PART OF JUNE AND JULY THE TRADE ACTIVITY WAS SOMEWHAT RESTRICTED BY THE RELATIVELY

COOL WEATHER FOR THE SUMMER PERIOD, AND THE REDUCED DEMAND FOR ICE CREAM. SOME IMPROVEMENT HAS BEEN NOTED LATELY, AND THE MARKET TONE IS DESCRIBED AS HEALTHY. CERTAIN CLASSES, SUCH AS EVAPORATED CASE GOODS ARE SAID TO BE IN A FIRM POSITION. WHILE SOME PART OF THE PILING UP OF STOCKS WAS PROBABLY DUE TO SLOW TRADE, IT IS APPARENT THAT MOST OF IT MAY BE ATTRIBUTED TO THE BUILDING UP OF

STOCKS TO A MORE NORMAL LEVEL THAN THAT OF JUNE 1. PRODUCTION OF THESE PRODUCTS IS READILY RESPONSIVE TO IMMEDIATE MARKET NEEDS AND IT IS CLEARLY SHOWN IN THE DEVELOPMENTS OF THIS PAST MONTH. LATE ADVISES SHOW SOME FALLING OFF IN OPERATIONS IN LATE JULY.
