STOCKS CONTINUE HEAVY ON CANNED MILK MARKETS

THERE HAS BEEN BUT LITTLE CHANGE IN POSITION ON THE CONDENSED AND EVAPORATED MILK MARKETS DURING FEBRUARY. THE FASIER TONE SEEN AT THAT TIME IS STILL IN EVIDENCE, AND SALES HAVE BEEN RATHER SENERALLY QUIET. SOME OF THE LACK OF STRENGTH IS CAUSED BY THE HEAVY STOCKS IN THE HANDS OF MANUFACTURERS. THESE STOCKS ON FEBRUARY | AMOUNTED TO 147,651,596 POUNDS. A YEAR EARLIER THE STOCKS WERE SO,227,588 POUNCS, AND THE FIVE YEAR 4VERAGE FOR FEBRUARY | 18 108,457,976 POUNCS. IT SHOULD BE NOTED, HOWEVER, THAT THE REDUCTION FROM JANUARY | TO FEBRUARY | WAS SOMEWHAT LARGER THAN

PRODUCTION OF THESE CONCENTRATED MILKS WAS LESS IN JANUARY THAN THE PREVIOUS YEAR BY ABOUT 4%. THIS IS RATHER STRIKING WHEN IT IS NOTED THAT PRACTICALLY ALL OF THE OTHER DAIRY PRODUCTS HAVE BEEN PRODUCED, THUS FAR IN 1928, CONSIDERABLY IN EXCESS OF A YEAR AGO. FOR JANUARY THE INCREASE IN BUTTER PRODUCTION WAS ESTIMATED AT ABOUT 7%, WHILE CHEESE PRODUCTION APPEARED TO BE SOME IT LARGER THAN THE PREVIOUS YEAR. THESE FIGURES BRING OUT THE FACT THAT THE PRODUCTION OF CONDENSED AND EVAPORATED MILK CAN BE FAIRLY READILY ADJUSTED TO SUPPLY CONDITIONS, AND SUGGEST RATHER

WHILE THERE HAS BEEN NOTHING OF STETANDING INTEREST IN THE FOREIGN TRADE SITUATION IT IS INTEREST NOTE THAT EXPORTS OF BOTH CONDENSED, AND EVAPORATED WERE COLEIDERABLY LARGER IN JANUARY, 1928

DEFINITELY THAT SOME SUCH ADJUSTMENT HAS THAN IN JANUARY, 1927. THIS INCREASE SEEN MADE IN THIS CASE. RECENT REPORTS VARIED FROM ABOUT 30% IN THE CASE OF FROM MARKET CENTERS SHOW THAT THIS ENAPORATED TO APPROXIMATELY 40% FOR CONDENSED. WHILE THESE LARGE PERCENTAGES DO NOT MEAN LARGE AMOUNTS, YET THIS TENDENCY, IF CONTINUED ON THROUGH THE YEAR WOULD BE A VERY IMPORTANT CHANGE IN OUR EXPORT TRADE.

This report is the fourth of a series which are to be issued quarterly showing stocks in the hands of wholesale grocers. Comparisons with last year are impossible at this time, since information regarding 1926 stocks is not available. Such comparisons can be made as future reports are issued.
